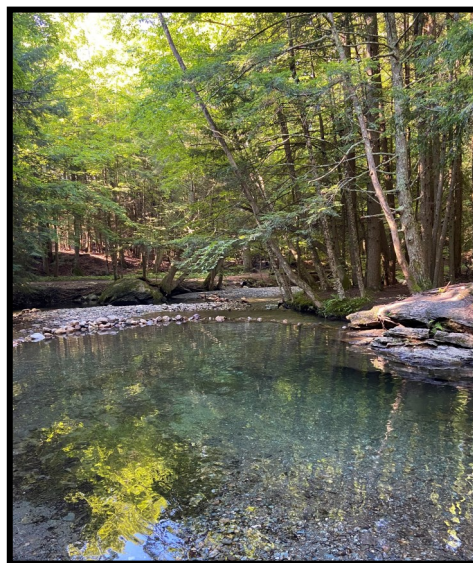

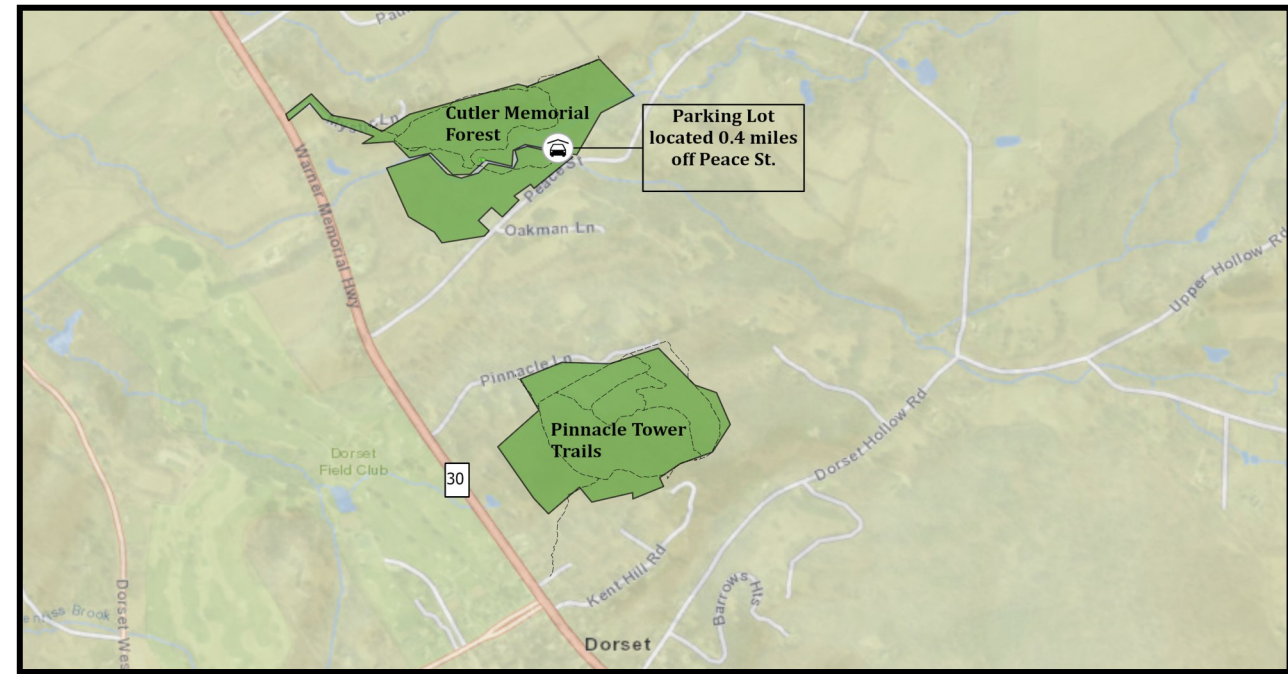


CUTLER MEMORIAL FOREST

Flowing down from Dorset Peak, the Mettawee River runs through Cutler Memorial Forest among the beautiful hemlocks. The section of Mettawee in Cutler has not been manipulated by human alterations. The water flow has shifted and changed naturally with time.
