"Advanced Power Strips can help save kwh and \$"

When your electronics are off, they may still use power, and you pay for it. An Advanced Power Strip (APS) shuts off the power for you.





The Dorset Players conclude their 83rd anniversary season with Gilbert and Sullivan's classic operetta "H.M.S. Pinafore." Proudly sponsored by Mettowee Mill Nursery, Casella Waste Management and R.K. Miles, performances will run Thursday, Friday and Saturday, May 19, 20, 21, 26, 27 & 28 at 7:30 p.m and Sunday on May 22 & 29 at 2:00 p.m.

Subtitled "The Lass Who Loved a Sailor," "H.M.S. Pinafore" pokes fun at British social and military pecking orders in the Victorian era. It follows the travails of the daughter of a Captain in the Royal Navy; ardent to wed a lad below her station, she foils the desire of her ostensibly more suitable suitor, Sir Joseph Porter, K.C.B.

Director Jeff Linebeck and Music Director Joanne Beck have been busy rehearsing and cajoling a talented cast into harmonic trim. Soprano Danielle Houston of Whitehall, New York is featured as Captain Corcoran's daughter, Josephine. Danielle's mother, Kathleen Wilson, joins her daughter on-stage as the pleasing, yet mysterious Buttercup.

Cameron Steinmetz, an accomplished tenor who has appeared with the Opera Theatre of Weston, is Ralph Rackstraw, a lowly foremast hand and Josephine's true love. Other members of Captain Corcoran's gallant crew include Denny Rogers as the Carpenter, Bob Bushnell as the Boatswain, and Skip Dickinson as the mischievous Dick Deadeye. Also onboard are Bob Davidson, Saul Kimmel, John Sease and his son, William Sease, as well as cabin boys and real life siblings, Julian Woodrow and Adrian Chirtea.

Julie Citron portrays Hebe, who maneuvers to win the heart of Sir Joseph Porter. Other sisters, cousins and aunts in Sir Joseph's entourage are played by Janet Saint Germain, CeCe King, Lilly Himmelman, Frances Yackel, Kya Davis, Anna Foster, and Heather Chirtea, Julian and Adrian's real life mom.


