

### **Dorset Build Out Survey**

In late 2012 the Town of Dorset was awarded a municipal planning grant for a "Build Out Study". The grant will allow the Dorset Planning Commission to work with the Bennington County Regional Commission (BCRC) to provide an analysis of future growth patterns in Dorset.

The Planning Commission has started the project with a town wide survey that will be mailed to all Dorset property owners in the next month. The survey is one page and a stamped return envelope is provided. The Planning Commission is hopeful that all residents will take the time to respond. The information collected by the survey will be extremely valuable as town planners embark on analyzing our current patterns of growth and choosing a direction for future growth.



### Town Clerk's Corner

The Town Clerk's Office is responsible for the recording of all land records, maintaining all vital records, supervising elections, issuing fish & wildlife licenses, dog licenses, and renewal of motor vehicle registrations.

• Dog Licenses are due by **APRIL 1st**: Dog Licenses are \$10.00 for dogs that are spayed or neutered and \$14.00 if the dog is not spayed or neutered. Proof of a current rabies vaccine is required. After April 1st the fees increase to \$12.00 and \$18.00


